

## Third Northern Mariana Islands Constitutional Convention

Delegate Proposal No. 471

Date: June 19,1995

It is proposed that a constitutional amendment be prepared that does the following:

Abolishes the 60-day re-employment provision so that retirees eligible to be re-employed pursuant to law, in any capacity, whether classified or under any contract with the government, will lose pension benefits immediately upon reemployment with the government. This provision should not be subject to legislative changes.

Permits re-employment of retirees (double-dipping) under the following terms:

.The additional salary and service earned shall not be used in the computation of benefits upon reinstatement of retiree status.
