RESOLUTION NO. 3

COMMONWEALTH OF THE NORTHERN MARIANA ISLANDS

A CONSTITUTIONAL CONVENTION RESOLUTION

Commonwealth Legislature to take expedited action upon and pass H.B. 9-408 which provides for a special election for the ratification by the people of the amendments to the CNMI Constitution proposed by the Third Northern Marianas Constitutional Convention.

WHEREAS, the Third Constitutional Convention of the Northern Mariana
 Islands ("Convention") convened on June 5, 1995 and is mandated by P.L. 9-18
 to adjourn on August 4, 1995 with the possibility of an extension of 15 days
 through no later than August 19, 1995; and

5 WHEREAS, the general election for 1995 is scheduled to take place on 6 November 4, 1995 in accordance with Article VII, section 1 of the 7 Commonwealth Constitution; and

8 WHEREAS, the Convention is charged with the responsibility to review
9 the entire Commonwealth Constitution and propose amendments as it deems fit;
10 and

11 WHEREAS, thus far more than 400 delegate proposals have been 12 submitted to the Convention for its consideration, which proposals embrace a 13 wide variety of issues and could potentially affect every article of the 14 Constitution;

WHEREAS, Article XVIII, section 5 (a) of the Constitution provides that "[a] proposed amendment to [the] Constitution shall be submitted to the voters for ratification at the next regular election or at a special election established by law," and

WHEREAS, Public Law 9-18, section 19 (a), provides that the ratification
 of amendments proposed by the Convention shall take place on the November
 1995 regular general election; and

1 WHEREAS, under the statutory scheme of P.L. 9-18 as enacted, there 2 would be less than a three months gap between the end of the Convention and 3 the general election; and

WHEREAS, such time is clearly insufficient for public education and full public debate on the issues to be raised by the proposed amendments; and

6 WHEREAS, insufficient public debate could deprive the mating public of 7 a reasonable opportunity to form an informed opinion on critical issues which 8 will likely determine the course of the Commonwealth for many years to 9 come;; and

10 WHEREAS, there is the further danger that placing the proposed 11 amendments to the Constitution on a general election ballot would overly 12 politicize the ratification process and detract from the substantive policy 13 issues represented by the proposed amendments; and

14 WHEREAS, in recognition of the above concerns, Representatives Jesus 15 T. Attao and Oscar M. Babauta introduced and the House of Representatives 16 passed House Bill 9-408 which would provide for a special election for the 17 ratification of amendments to the Constitution proposed by the Convention to 18 take place six months after the 1995 general election; and

19 WHEREAS, House Bill 9-408 now awaits the action of the Senate; now 20 therefore,

21 BE IT RESOLVED, that the Third Northern Marianas Constitutional 22 Convention hereby respectfully urges the Senate of the Ninth Commonwealth 23 Legislature, in consideration of all the concerns herein stated, to expeditiously 24 act upon and pass House Bill 9-408 for the benefit of all of the people of the 25 Commonwealth; and

26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the President of the Convention shall 27 certify and the Secretary of the Convention shall attest to the adoption of this 28 resolution and thereafter transmit copies to the President of the Senate; to all 29 members of the Senate; to the Speaker of the House; to all members of the 30 House of Representatives; and to the Honorable Froilan C. Tenorio, Governor of 31 the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands.
