



It is proposed that a constitutional amendment be prepared that does the following:

Adds a severability clause to the enforcement provision of Article XII.

[Note: This would allow the courts flexibility to cut out provisions of leases that violate Article XII, and to allow the rest of the lease to remain in effect.]
