
Delegate Proposal No. 476

Date: June 20, 1995

It is proposed that a constitutional amendment be prepared that does the following:

Adds a statute of limitations of 6 years to the enforcement provisions of Article XII.

[Note: This would mean that transactions that violate Article XII could be challenged for six years after the date of the transaction. After that, these transactions would be fully enforceable and no defects in title would result from these transactions.]
