

Delegate Proposal No. 477

Date: June 20,1995

It is proposed that a constitutional amendment be prepared that does the following:

Provides that the Governor must make a decision within 90 days when the Executive Assistant for Carolinian Affairs reports findings or recommendations to the Governor.

Provides that it is the duty of the Executive Assistant for Carolinian Affairs to formulate and implement a policy of affirmative action in the government and private sectors to assist the indigenous Carolinians to achieve social, political, and economic parity.

Provides that the Executive Assistant for Carolinian Affairs is authorized to hire staff for carrying out assigned duties and responsibilities.

Provides that the Executive Assistant for Carolinian Affairs is authorized to issue rules and regulations for carrying out assigned duties and responsibilities.

Provides that the Governor shall include in the budget of the executive branch the funding necessary to fully implement the provisions of the Constitution affecting the Executive Assistant for Carolinian Affairs.
