
Dear Mr. Governor:

I am writing at the request of the Committee on Executive Branch and Local Government regarding the Committee's public hearings scheduled for the Senate Chamber on Tuesday, June 27, 1995, from 9:00 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. The Committee will be hearing testimony on various provisions of Article III of the Constitution (Executive Branch).

The Committee is especially interested in soliciting views regarding the constitutional offices for Carolinian Affairs, Indigenous Affairs and Women's Affairs; the processing of the Commonwealth's budget; whether the Attorney General should be an elected office; coordination between the offices of the Attorney General and the Public Auditor; and the Governor's reorganization authority. I am sure that there are other issues that you or your representatives would like to bring to the attention of the Committee with respect to Article III and these public hearings provide an excellent opportunity for you to do so.
