Re:Supplemental Article II Agenda

Several new proposals have been assigned to the Committee. How does the Committee wish to deal with them? Counsel suggest that new proposals dealing with agenda items we have discussed be deferred until after the entire agenda has been considered once, while new proposals dealing with items which remain on the agenda be dealt with by way of supplemental agenda. If this is acceptable to the Committee, the following supplemental item should be placed on the agenda.

Item 12. Section 7 - Governor's Action. New proposal 422

C. Shall the Legislature be required to act on all appointments within 25 days? If the legislature does not act timely, shall the appointment be deemed confirmed?
