Delegate Proposal No. 489

Date: June 22, 1995

It is proposed that a constitutional amendment be prepared that does the following:

Provides a common structure for all boards and commissions as follows:

- (1) The governing body may have no more than 5 members.
- (2) The members must meet minimum qualifications:
  - . U.S. citizen
  - . CNMI residence for at least 3 years
- (3) The members may not be employed by any other government entity while serving on the board or commission
- (4) The members serve a term that ends with the term of the governor that appointed them.
- (5) The members may be removed only for cause.
