

Third Northern Mariana Islands Constitutional Convention

Delegate Proposal No. 507

Date: June 24, 1995

It is proposed that a constitutional amendment be prepared that does the following:

Establishes a University of the Marianas-Saipan as the Commonwealth university.

Provides for the transfer of title to real and personal property to the university.

Provides for a Board of Regents with two members each from Saipan, Rota, Tinian, and the Northern Islands who are appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent of the Senate

- the Board would formulate policy for the university and have such other functions as provided by law

Provides for a President who is appointed by the Board of Regents.

- the President would be the chief executive officer of the university

Provides that the university would have as a principal goal encouraging, furthering, and rehabilitating the Chamerro and Carolinian language culture and history
