Delegate Proposal No. 566

It is proposed that a constitutional amendment be prepared that does the following:

Requires that all bills be passed by a majority of the members in each house.

[Note: This will prevent a bill from being passed by less than the majority of the members. For example, when a quorum for a meeting is established and two members leave, a bill can be passed by a majority of the members present, which is less than a majority of the members.]
