



Third Northern Mariana Islands Constitutional Convention

Delegate Proposal No. 554

Date: July 9, 1995

It is proposed that a constitutional amendment be prepared that does the following:

Amends Article I, Section 3(b) to provide for electronic surveillance with the consent of one of the parties to the surveillance.

[Note: The Attorney General explains that this is the same standard used by all federal law enforcement agencies. This should assist the CNMI and federal law enforcement agencies as they continue to combat the problems of crimes and the evils caused by drugs in the CNMI.]
