Delegate Proposal No. 592

Date: July 10, 1995

It is proposed that a constitutional amendment be prepared that does the following:

Provides that the public auditor may appoint a special prosecutor (and may designate in-house counsel) to prosecute violations of Commonwealth law dealing with government moneys or property or seek recovery of government funds or property, and to seek declaratory and injunctive relief in those areas.
