Delegate Proposal No. 600

A STATE OF THE STA

Date: July 10, 1995

It is proposed that a constitutional amendment be prepared that does the following:

Amends the duties and responsibilities of the resident executive for indigenous affairs to include --

- (1) coordination and promotion of the education for and practice of the traditional art of healing
- (2) coordination and promotion of the education for and practice of arts and crafts of the indigenous peoples of the CNMI; and ensure the preservation of all media of traditional arts and crafts
- (3) hiring of traditional specialists and staff and promulgate rules and regulations in carrying out a futies of the office.

Delete from the duties and responsibilities it the resident executive the reference to "coordinate an annual cultural festival" as this is already done by the CCAC.
