



# Third Northern Mariana Islands Constitutional Convention -1554-

Delegate Proposal No. 613

Date: July 10, 1995

It is proposed that a constitutional amendment be prepared that does the following:

Provides for municipal government on Saipan, as follows --

(1) Precincts: Precincts on Saipan would be defined by the Municipal Council. As an interim measure, the Schedule on Transitional Matters would define the precincts:

. Precinct 1: San Antonio, San Vicente, Koblerville, Dan Dan, Kagman 2, and Kagman 3.

. Precinct 2: Chalan Kanoa 1, 2, 3, and 4 and Susupe.

. Precinct 3: San Jose (Oleai), Gualo Rai (upper and lower), Garapan (central, lower, and Navy Hill).

. Precinct 4: Tanapag, San Roque, Capitol Hill, As Matuis, As Teo, and Kagman 1.

2) Precinct Representatives: The Mayor's Office shall include four Mayor's Precinct Representatives appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the Municipal Council. The Representatives shall supervise geographic areas of the municipality, under the direct supervision and control of the Mayor, and shall have such other duties and responsibilities as the Mayor may assign.
