In accordance with your instructions, I personally delivered a copy of Report Number 5 on Article II: Legislative Branch, together with the proposed language of Article II as amended, to Speaker Diego T. Benavente today. I explained to him that the proposed amendment to the article passed first reading on July 11, 1995 and that it still needs to pass the Convention on a second reading. I also personally delivered a copy of the same article to Senate President Juan S. Demapan's secretary Priscilla M. Torres. The Senate President is presently off-island and will not be returning until next month. Ms. Torres informed me that copies of the documents will be given to the other senators.

Also on this date, I personally delivered a copy of Report Number 2 on Article V: Representation in the United States and the proposed language of sections 1 and 2 of Article V as adopted and passed on first reading on July 6, 1995 to the Washington Representative's Saipan Office. The Washington Representative's secretary, Carmen Reyes, faxed the documents to the Washington Representative in D.C. from their fax machine.

Finally, I personally delivered a copy of Report Number 5 on Article XIV: Natural Resources, and the proposed language of Article XIV as amended, to Secretary Benigno M. Sablan's secretary, Roslyn Cepeda, at the Secretary's office in lower base.
