Dear Honorable Ogumoro-

In regards to your letter dated 13 June 1995, Pagan is still not safe for permanent resettlement. We have recommended approval for the establishment of the Pagan Island Marine Youth Camp on the condition that they meet two requirements: (1) prepare an Evacuation Plan for all personnel and (2) have one person from our office install and monitor a portable seismograph. The Evacuation Plan must establish a boat, ship, or aircraft large enough to accommodate all personnel on sight at all times should the need for immediate evacuation arise.

Mt. Pagan remains active. Our office records minor tremors and ashes, gas, and smoke spewing into the air on a regular basis. These activities make the Island unsate for permanent habitation.




