

Third Northern Mariana Islands Constitutional Convention-2408-

Delegate Amendment No. 009

Date: July 20, 1995

ARTICLE AND SECTION TO BE AMENDED: Art. I, Section 9

COMMITTEE ASSIGNED: Committee on Land and Personal Rights

It is proposed that the article passed on first reading be amended as follows:

Article I

Section 9: Clean and Healthful Environment

Each person has the right to a clean and healthful environment <u>as provided by law</u>. The legislature shall enact no law infringing this right or permitting or permitting storage or dumping of any nuclear or radioactive material in the lands or waters of the Commonwealth. <u>Any person may enforce this right against public or private parties as provided by law</u>.

Notes: This deletes the term "public environment" and thus covers private property. This adds a qualifying phrase "as provided by law" and thus limits the right to a clean and healthful environment to the aspects of that right covered by laws on environmental quality, pollution control, conservation, and protection and enhancement of natural resources. This adds a private cause of action that may be regulated if the legislature chooses to do so. Lawsuits would be brought by any person, as a private attorney general, if the person suing thought that the government was not acting quickly enough or with the right priorities.
