Delegate Amendment No. 021

Date: July 21, 1995

ARTICLE AND SECTION TO BE AMENDED: Article II, Section 2

COMMITTEE ASSIGNED: Committee on Legislative Branch and Public Finance

It is proposed that the article passed on first reading be amended as follows:

Article II

Section 2: Composition of the Senate

a) The senate shall consist of six members elected at large in the Commonwealth with two members elected from each of the senatorial districts. The first senatorial district shall consist of Rota, the second senatorial district shall consist of Tinian and Aguiguan, and the third senatorial district shall consist of Saipan and the islands north of it. The senate shall be increased to eight members elected at large in the Commonwealth and two members shall be elected from a fourth senatorial district consisting of the islands north of Saipan at the first regular general election after the population of these islands exceeds one thousand persons.
