ARTICLE AND SECTION TO BE AMENDED: Article XVIII, Section 2

COMMITTEE ASSIGNED: Committee on Judiciary and Other Elected

It is proposed that the article passed on first reading be amended as follows:

Article XVIII

Section 2: Amendment by Constitutional Convention

An initiative petition may submit to the voters the question, "Shall there be a constitutional convention to propose amendments to the Constitution?" The petition shall be signed by at least forty percent of the persons qualified to vote in the Commonwealth. An initiative petition for this purpose may not be used until the year 2021.
