

## Third Northern Mariana Islands Constitutional Convention -2813-

**Delegate Amendment No.** 028 Date: July 21, 1995

## ARTICLE AND SECTION TO BE AMENDED: Article II, Section 7

COMMITTEE ASSIGNED: Committee on Legislative Branch and Public Finance

It is proposed that the article passed on first reading be amended as follows:

Article II

## Section 7: Action on Legislation by the Governor

c) A bill or item, section or part of a bill vetoed by the governor may be reconsidered by the legislature. <u>The governor shall transmit the vetoed bill to the legislature within five working days from the date of the veto.</u> The legislature shall have sixty days from the receipt of the governor's veto message in the house of origin of the vetoed bill, item, section or part of a bill to reconsider the vetoed legislation. If two-thirds of the members in each house vote upon reconsideration to pass the bill, item, section or part, it shall become law.

Notes: This amendment adds a time limit for the governor to act. This does not affect the veto power.
