REPORT OF THE COMMITTEE ON LEGISLATIVE BRANCH AND PUBLIC FINANCE

ARTICLE XV (formerly XXI), GAMBLING, SECOND READING

The Committee presents the following report to the delegates with respect to Article XV (formerly XXI), Gambling, on second reading.

<u>Delegate Proposals</u>. The Committee's Report No. 3 is dated June 21, 1995.¹ Thereafter, Delegate Proposals 455, 572 and 608 were introduced. The Committee considered these proposals and concluded that they raised issues better dealt with by each senatorial district that approves casino gambling.

<u>Floor Discussion</u>. The Committee of the Whole discussed Report No. 1 on June 19, 1995. Comments from several delegates produced a revised report which the Committee of the Whole discussed and adopted on June 22, 1995.

<u>Delegate Amendments.</u> The Committee has received no Delegate Amendments with respect to this article.

<u>Committee Changes.</u> This article has ben renumbered to eliminate gaps left as articles were consolidated. The Committee recommends no further changes to the text of this article.

<u>Summary</u>. The Committee recommends passage of Article XV on second reading.
