AMENDMENT NO. 1 Continued. . . .

Section 8: No change.

Section 8: Trial by jury.

Section 9: Delete the power of the legislature to permit dumping of nuclear wastes; delete reference to noise pollution as proper subject for legislation not constitution.

Section 9: **Clean and Healthful Environment.**
Each person has the right to a clean and healthful public environment. The legislature shall enact no law infringing this right or permitting the storage or dumping of any nuclear or radioactive material in the lands or waters of the Commonwealth.

Section 10: No change.

Section 10: Privacy.

Current Section 11 on victims of crime is deleted entirely. The legislature has acted to provide this protection. It provides:
The right of individual privacy shall not be infringed except upon a showing of compelling interest.

Victims of crime: The right of the people to be secure in their persons, houses, and belongings against crime shall be recognized as sentencing. Restitution to the crime victim shall be a condition of probation and parole except upon a showing of compelling interest.

Section 11: Replaces current Section 12 to recognize Commonwealth's fundamental support for each individual's life. (This is new.)

Section 11: Life.
The right to life for every individual during the entire span from conception through old age is respected, honored and protected in the Commonwealth. This right is subject to definition and regulation by the legislature.

Current Section 12 on abortion has been deleted entirely. It provides:

Abortion: The abortion of the unborn child during the mother's pregnancy is prohibited in the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands, except as provided by law.
