Rebels: Burmese army preparing new offensive

BANGKOK, Thailand (AP) — The Burmese army is preparing a major offensive against the last sizeable rebel army fighting the government in Rangoon, rebel leaders said Thursday.

The army has been forcibly rounding up Karen villagers to carry munitions and supplies, and burning villages and crops to lay the groundwork for an attack, say representatives of the Karen National Union.

"Now that Khun Sa has surrendered we will definitely be seeing more government troops

sent to fight against us," said U Nu, a spokesman for the KNU in a telephone interview with The Associated Press.

He was referring to the notorious opium warlord and ethnic Shan independence fighter who agreed to surrender his nearly 20,000 troop Mong Tai Army to the Burmese government on Tuesday.

The Karen are the last major ethnic group fighting for autonomy from the government in Rangoon. A victory over, or peace with the Karen, would give the Burmese government almost

complete control over its border, something it has not had since the nation's independence.

Since the Karen began their struggle, shortly after Burma was granted independence from Britain in 1948, they have been pushed from the outskirts of Rangoon to the malaria-infested hills along the Thai-Burmese border south of the area where Khun Sa operates.

KNU brigades in the Tamu District of Burma say an attack by the Burmese army is imminent.

"The military clearly plans

an offensive to try to gain complete military control of the region," said Steve Dun, a KNU spokesman. "The military has been on a systematic campaign of destroying villages and burning crops and food supplies."

Dun said the Burmese army has ordered Karen villagers in the area to relocate to a labor camp, and those who do not comply will be shot.

They have also been ordered to provide 530 porters and trucks, he said.

The Burmese army has been accused by several human rights organizations of forcing villagers to serve as porters.

In a brutal form of forced

labor they carry supplies for the army, sometimes using human shields in the fields. Those who are too sick to carry supplies are severely beaten, he said.

"All of the suffering at a time when the government claims to be bringing peace will be a disaster," he said.

KNU delegates met in 1994 with government representatives in hopes of a cease-fire. The talks, however, have not taken place in the past several months. In March, Nepalese

Curators stumble upon rare Darwin bird specimens

MELBOURNE, Australia (AP) — Curators at the Museum of Victoria have stumbled upon two preserved birds collected by Charles Darwin while he was formulating his theory of evolution last century.

The specimens discovered in the vaults of the museum where they have been stored and forgotten about for generations.

Both carry identification tags handwritten by the legendary British naturalist, the Age newspaper reported on Thursday.

Les Christidis, a bird expert at the museum, said the finch and a small bush bird were one of many trapped by Darwin as he sailed along South America's

Pacific coast on the scientific ship HMS Beagle between 1831 and 1836.

Darwin drew up his theories of evolution and natural selection based on observations he made during the voyage.

His 1859 book "Origin of the Species" is regarded as one of the science's greatest achievements. It created a furor at the time because it countered traditional Christian beliefs on how humankind was created.

During the Beagle expedition Darwin noted small differences in the beaks of finches on the Galapagos Islands compared with those on the mainland and others found as fossils.

Darwin decided the birds had

adapted their beaks to forage for different types of food found in different habitats.

Christidis said the discovery of the birds is of international significance. It has long been believed that all of Darwin's specimens had been documented decades ago.

"There have been no reports for a very long time of any Darwin specimens. We are very fortunate," he said.

The birds were probably brought to Australia from Britain in the 1880s by one of the museum's founders.

Christidis is searching among other stored exhibits in case other Darwin specimens are there.


