Bomb rips Jerusalem bus

JERUSALEM (AP) - A bomb exploded on a bus in downtown Jerusalem on Sunday, killing at least 10 people and wounding at least 20 others. Israeli radio and television

said. A second bus and several other vehicles were damaged in Sunday morning's explosion, which occurred near the city's main bus station.

Military sources said several soldiers were on the bus. The blast reduced the back of the red city bus to a twisted ball of charred metal.

Police kept onlookers away

for fear of a second explosion, while searchers with plastic bags retrieved body parts.

An official at the Hadassah-Fein Karem hospital said twelve wounded people were brought to the hospital and that a few were in serious condition.

The explosion came only two days after Israel lifted an 11-day closure of the Palestinian West Bank and Gaza Strip that had been imposed to prevent attacks by Muslim militants. It was the first bombing since August.

Israeli officials had received warnings that the militants were planning suicide attacks

to avenge the death of their chief bomb-maker, Yehiyeh Ayyash, who was assassinated Jan. 5 in an operation widely attributed to Israel.

Ayyash had orchestrated at least seven suicide bombings that killed 55 people over the past two years.

The bombing comes at an extremely sensitive time for the government.

Prime Minister Shimon Peres has moved up national elections from October to May 29, and while running ahead of his hard-line opponent, he is likely to lose support as a result of the attack.

2 quakes felt near Tokyo

TOKYO (AP) - A pair of moderate earthquakes hit an area northeast of Tokyo Sunday, but there were no reports of injuries or damage.

A 3.8-magnitude quake centered in the Pacific Ocean off Ibaraki prefecture (state), struck at 5:38 a.m. (2058 GMT), the Central Meteorological Agency said.

It was followed at 6:38 a.m. (2138 GMT) by a 4.3-magnitude quake, also centered in

the Pacific off Ibaraki, the agency said.

Both quakes were focused at a depth of about 40 kilometers (25 miles) undersea, the agency said.

An earthquake with a magnitude of 5 can cause considerable damage if centered near a populated area.

The first quake registered a 2 on the Japanese scale in the city of Mito, located 100 kilometers (63 miles) northeast of Tokyo, while

the second registered a 1 there, the agency said.

A Mito police official said there were no reports of damage and that the earthquakes were barely, if at all, felt.

The Japanese scale, which is not directly convertible to magnitude, measures the intensity of an earthquake at various places.

A quake's magnitude measures the energy released as measured by ground motion recorded on a seismograph.

Checked past haunts Miami

MIAMI (AP) - A Miami police chief said Sunday that the city's past haunts, including the bad old days of the '80s and '90s, are back, but Miami still has a lot to offer. Miami police Chief Donald Warshaw said after hearing news of the killing.
