SUBJECT : Meetings for Education on Proposed Amendments to Constitution

The Post Convention Committee has requested the opportunity to explain the proposed amendments to the Commonwealth Constitution to all government employees. They have asked that time be made available for employees to attend such meetings, hear an explanation of the changes recommended by the 1995 Convention, and ask questions regarding the proposed amendments.

I agree that this is a good idea and hereby direct that all department heads permit their employees to attend such meetings, consistent with the continued functioning of their offices during business hours. The Constitutional Convention has recommended some very important changes to our Constitution and the way in which all three branches of government will do their business in the future if the amendments are ratified by the voters at the general election on November 4, 1995.

A schedule of the proposed meetings with government employees will be circulated by the Post Convention Committee in the near future. Please make every effort to ensure that your employees have an opportunity to attend at least one of these meetings.
