- 1. Call to Order -- Chair H.T. Guerrero called the meeting to order at 9:47 am.
- 2. Ascertain Quorum Quorum was ascertained with members F. Nogis, T. Aldan, VChair E. Fleming, Sec. J. Gonzales, and Chair H.T. Guerrero present. Counsels H. Willens and D. Siemers were also present.
- 3. Approval of 10/17/95 Minutes -- adoption of 10/17 minutes was tabled.

#### 4. Reports

- a. Status of Translations -- (1) the Chamorro and Carolinian translations of the Constitution have yet to be finalized and submitted to the Post Convention Committee for sanctioning and subsequent dissemination to interested parties and the NMC Archives. Apparently both Dr. Rita H. Inos and Jesus Elameto' are off-island tending to a funeral and a stateside conference, respectively. Alice Guerrero will follow up with Dr. Inos, while Del. F. Nogis with Mr. Elameto.
- b. Public Education -- (1) in light of the precedence set with the lack of attendants at the village meetings, the Committee decided to allow Alice Guerrero to reserve ad spaces in advance with the respective radio and television stations and process the contracts for the Chair's signature in time for January next year; (2) the schedule for village meetings and government departments will be the same with the dates changed to reflect next year.

Discussion also ensued on the need for an extremely aggressive public education campaign to overcome the potential challenges from special interest groups and opponents of the local government amendments such as from Rota. While away, Howard and Deanne will draft a masterplan for things to do from now until January or February of 1996.

#### 5. Old Business

a. Loan of Billboards -- Somehow, some people within the committee will be asking either the parties, precinct clubs and/or individual candidates for the upcoming November elections to loan their billboards for use by the Post Convention Committee to put up signs urging the voters in all 3 islands to vote Yes on all the proposed amendments.


