THE VOTE ON THE CONSTITUTION IS IMPORTANT FOR EVERYONE

Your 27 elected delegates, 19 from Saipan, 4 from Rota, and 4 from Tinian, worked at the Convention until we had agreement on what was best for the Commonwealth. No minority or majority groups existed. We all worked together to come up with 19 recommended amendments.

Some of the amendments are easier to understand than others. But all of them are important.

If you are uncertain how to vote, consider the votes of the 27 elected delegates, who acted at the Convention on a non-partisan basis after having studied these matters carefully. On almost all matters there was agreement among the delegates
