RESOLUTION OF THE POST CONVENTION COMMITTEE

WHEREAS, Public Law 9-18 authorizes the Post Convention Committee to prepare an Analysis of the amendments proposed by the Third Constitutional Convention if one has not been prepared;

WHEREAS, counsel has advised the Post Convention Committee that the authority granted the Committee by Public Law 9-18 necessarily includes the more limited authority to revise the Analysis approved by the Convention if such corrections or additions are necessary to state more clearly the intentions of the Convention in proposing any particular amendment;

WHEREAS, during the public education program conducted by the Committee over the past six months the Committee has become aware of certain errors and omissions in the Analysis whose correction would clarify the intentions underlying the amendments proposed by the Convention and avoid unnecessary disputes and litigation in the future; and

WHEREAS, the Committee after discussing the matter thoroughly has decided to make the corrections and revisions to the Analysis set forth on the attached Correction Sheets for the Analysis; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED that the Post Convention Committee approves the corrections and revisions to the Analysis set forth on the attached Correction Sheets for the Analysis and directs the Secretary and staff of the Committee to issue a Press Release describing this action of the Committee before March 2, 1996.
