

Peruant to our Governor's memorandum regarding the Executive Branch resources, I would like to submit herewith the Council for Arts and Culture's input and support of this very important Convention.

The Convention Center is open from July through August, 1995. Attached is the pre-arranged schedule of activities for this Center. Earlier I sent a calendar of activities which our office sponsors, which were sent to your office for information and reference. The Arts Council will conduct the first ever International Arts and Crafts Fair in the Convention Center from March 31 to April 20. Following this exhibit, the Arts Council will hold the Children's Traveling Exhibit (a regional project between the CNMI, Guam, and American Samoa), from April 22 to May 25, 1995. Following this exhibit, we will hold the Sixth Annual Micronesian Crafts Exhibit from June 1-30, 1995. The Convention Center will be available for the Convention delegates' use during July and August. In September, the Arts Council will conduct the annual Island Artists' Exhibit, and immediately following that will be the Governor's Awards in the Arts, conducted in October.
