

Delegate Proposal No. 71

Date: March 22, 1995

It is proposed that a constitutional amendment be prepared that does the following:

Deletes Article XV on Education, in order to do away with both an elected School Board and an appointed School Board, and the constitutional provision for the Northern Marianas College.

Substitutes a Department of Education within the Executive branch headed by a Superintendent of Education appointed by the Governor.
