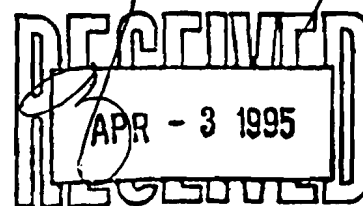
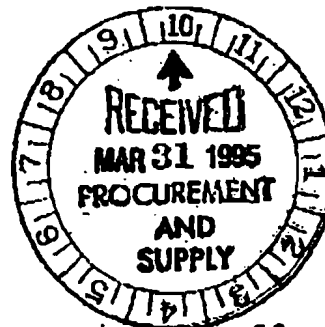

The Pre-Convention Committee of the Third Constitutional Convention will be convening soon. As part of its duties, the Pre-Convention Committee must ensure that accommodations, facilities, equipment, and staff support for the Convention are available.


Section 17 of the Third Constitutional Convention Enabling Act (P.L. 9-18) requires that the Governor and the presiding officers of the Legislature shall cooperate and make available, to the greatest extent practicable, the resources of the executive and legislative branches to support the Convention. The law says that this support should extend to accommodations, facilities, equipment, and staff support.

I am requesting that you provide a list of what facilities, equipment, and staff you can make available to support the Convention. This list could include (for example) secretarial and stenographic personnel, researchers, attorneys, computer equipment, telefax and photocopy machines, and meeting spaces for convention hearings and committee meetings. If some personnel or facilities are only available on a temporary or part-time basis, please indicate this on the list.

I have appointed my Special Assistant for Administration, Mr Joaquin I. Pangelinan, as Coordinator for Convention Services. He will be assembling the complete list of available assistance, and working with the Pre-Convention Committee and the Constitutional Committee. Please give your support information to him.

By copy of this memorandum, I am also asking for similar assistance from other entities.

I thank you for your cooperation in this matter.
