



Third Northern Mariana Islands Constitutional Convention -156-

Delegate Proposal No. 49

Date: May 2, 1995

It is proposed that a constitutional amendment be prepared that does the following:

Provides that the Legislature shall enact no law that permits non-U.S. citizens who are convicted of a felony in any place (their country, another country, or the U.S.) to enter the CNMI for any purpose.

Provides that the Legislature shall enact no law that permits non-U.S. citizens who are convicted of any crime in the CNMI to remain in the CNMI after conviction or to re-enter the CNMI at any time.

Requires that illegal aliens in the CNMI be deported and prohibited future entry into the CNMI.
