

Delegate Proposal No. 66

Date: May 2, 1995

It is proposed that a constitutional amendment be prepared that does the following:

Changes the provision for the emergency powers so that:

(1) in case of invasion, civil disturbance, and natural disaster, the Governor may act to deal with the emergency and report to the Legislature within 30 days.

(2) in case of "other calamity", the Governor may take action without legislative authorization only if the circumstances are such that the legislature cannot meet, in which case the Governor shall report to the Legislature within 30 days.
