It is proposed that a constitutional amendment be prepared that does the following:

Provides for qualifications required to hold the office of Attorney General:

- (1) The Attorney General must be a member of the CNMI bar and a registered voter in the CNMI.
- (2) The Attorney General must be at least 30 years of age.
- (3) The Attorney General must meet a residence requirement to the extent permitted by law.

Provides that the lawyers employed by the Attorney General must be a member of the CNMI bar and a registered voter in the CNMI.
