Delegate Proposal No. 29

Date: May 4, 1995

It is proposed that a constitutional amendment be prepared that does the following:

Reduces the size of the House of Representatives from 18 to 11 w/ 9 from Saipan & N.I., 1 ea. from Tinian & Rota all elected @ large.

Requires the election of all members of the House of Representatives on an island-wide, at-large basis. This would apply to Saipan, Rota, and Tinian. All members of the House elected from Saipan would be elected at-large on Saipan. The members from Rota and Tinian already are elected at-large on their islands.
