Delegate Proposal No. 9

Date: May 5, 1995

It is proposed that a constitutional amendment be prepared that does the following:

Deletes the Schedule on Transitional Matters from the 1976 Constitutional Convention now appended at the end of the Constitution.

The necessary legislative history should be provided to convey the intent of the Convention that the transition set out by the framers of the 1976 Constitution be carried forward without the continued use of the Schedule.

The Schedule on Transitional Matters would contain only transition provisions found necessary by the 1995 Constitutional Convention for amendments passed by it.

This is an updating proposal.
