
Delegate Proposal No. 146

It is proposed that a constitutional amendment be prepared that does the following:


Adds to the requirement that a bill be confined to one subject by providing that the subject of each bill be expressed clearly in its title.

Any provisions of the bill that fell outside the subject matter of the title would be void.
