Delegate Proposal No. 147


Date: May 8, 1995

It is proposed that a constitutional amendment be prepared that does the following:

Provides that the legislature may not enact a law except after three readings, and each of the three readings must take place on a separate calendar day.

The vote on the third reading may take place only after printed copies of the bill in its final form have been made available to the members for at least four consecutive calendar days.
