



Third Northern Mariana Islands Constitutional Convention -179-

Delegate Proposal No. 87

Date: May 10, 1995

It is proposed that a constitutional amendment be prepared that does the following:

Provides that the legislature shall meet in regular session for 120 consecutive calendar days each year, and may be convened at such other times at the call of the Governor.

Provides that if the Governor vetoes legislation within 40 days of the end of a regular session, he shall call the legislature in special session to consider overriding that veto.
