

Delegate Proposal No. 88

Date: May 10, 1995

It is proposed that a constitutional amendment be prepared that does the following:

Provides that appointments that require the advice and consent of the Senate shall be acted upon by the Senate within 25 days of the submission by the Governor. If the Senate fails to act within the time limit, the nominee shall take office as if the advice and consent of the Senate had been granted.

Provides that when acting upon appointments that require advice and consent of the Senate, the Senate shall sit with open doors. The votes shall be taken by yeas and nays and shall be entered on the Journal.
