Delegate Proposal No. 89

It is proposed that a constitutional amendment be prepared that does the following:

Provides that every order, resolution, or other matter as to which the concurrence of both houses of the legislature is necessary, except the question of adjournment, shall be presented to the Governor. Before such action by the legislature may take effect, it must be submitted to the Governor. If the Governor approves, it shall take effect. If the Governor does not approve, the matter shall be returned to the legislature. If two-thirds of the members in each house vote, upon reconsideration, to pass the order, resolution, or other matter, then it shall take effect.
