Delegate Proposal No. 214

It is proposed that a constitutional amendment be prepared that does the following:

Changes the provision with respect to elementary and secondary education from a free, compulsory system to a fee system from which fee exemptions may be granted by law.

Provides for length of residence as a qualification with respect to fee exemptions.

Increases the size of the Board of Education from 5 to 9 members.

Provides that four members shall be appointed by the Governor of which at least one shall be an active teacher; one shall be a parent; and one shall be a student.

Provides that all meetings of the Board of Education are open to the public.
