

Delegate Proposal No. 216

Date: May 10, 1995

It is proposed that a constitutional amendment be prepared that does the following:

Requires the Legislature, within two years, to establish a Commonwealth Health Insurance Plan to which all employed residents of the CNMI would belong.

Provides that the Plan will be financed by employers (60%) and employees (40%).

After the Plan has been in operation for six months, this provision of the Constitution will become void.
