Deletes the provision for a Legislative Bureau added in 1989 by legislative initiative.

This is a provision that was identified by counsel as legislative in nature.

CONSTITUTIONAL ARTICLES THAT WOULD BE AFFECTED: Art. II, Sec. 16 (without the additional section 17 providing separately for the Legislative Bureau budget, all of the legislature's budget would be under the ceiling provided by section 16.)
