

Delegate Proposal No. 158

Date: May 11, 1995

It is proposed that a constitutional amendment be prepared that does the following:

Changes the requirement for ratification of constitutional amendments to at least 2/3 of the votes cast Commonwealth-wide. This would apply no matter what method (constitutional convention, legislative initiative, or popular initiative) was used to amend the constitution.
