
It is proposed that a constitutional amendment be prepared that does the following:

Provides that gambling may be approved only by individual senatorial districts. Gambling may not be imposed by Commonwealth-wide measures.

Provides that gambling may be approved only by popular initiative within a senatorial district.

Provides that gambling may be approved only by a vote of 3/4 of the votes cast.
