Delegate Proposal No. 197

Date: May 11, 1995

It is proposed that a constitutional amendment be prepared that does the following:

Provides that the Commonwealth Supreme Court consists of a Chief Justice and at least two Associate Justices appointed by the Governor and confirmed by the Senate.

Provides that the Supreme Court has appellate jurisdiction over the final judgments and orders of the lower courts including such writs and orders as necessary to the full exercise of its powers.
