It is proposed that a constitutional amendment be prepared that does the following:

If the legislature retains the jurisdiction to determine the contested elections of one of its members (instead of giving this jurisdiction to the courts as is permitted, but not required, under the constitution), the member whose election is contested may not vote in the decision of the contest.
