Delegate Proposal No. 207

Date: May 11, 1995

It is proposed that a constitutional amendment be prepared that does the following:

Changes the requirement with respect to Northern Marianas descent from 25% to any percent (by deleting the 25% requirement).


Institutes a registry system within the Immigration Department so that everyone who claims to be of Northern Marianas descent can be listed.

Provides that the burden of proving Northern Marianas descent in the event of a challenge or contest, shall be on the claimant.
