



# Third Northern Mariana Islands Constitutional Convention -264-

Delegate Proposal No. 208

Date: May 11, 1995

It is proposed that a constitutional amendment be prepared that does the following:

Provides that adopted children of persons of Northern Marianas descent can hold fee simple title to land only if they receive it by inheritance from their adopted parents. Adopted children would not become persons of Northern Marianas descent for all purposes.
